Submission of the Manuscript. The authors are requested to submit one hard copy and the electronic version of the manuscript in any of these languages: Armenian, Russian or English.

Only papers not previously published will be accepted and authors must agree not to publish elsewhere a paper submitted to and accepted by the journal. By submitting a paper the author confirms that its submission for publication has been approved by all of the authors.

Preparation of the Manuscript for Submission. The maximum number of pages, including figures and tables, is limited to 10 for scientific articles and 4 for short communications. The papers should be prepared by Microsoft Word 2003–2010 editor versions, in accordance with the following styles: font – Times New Roman (Times Armenian for Armenian texts); font size – 12, line spacing – 1,5; paper – A4 with the margins of 2 *cm*. All formulas should be typesetted using MathType editor or the standard Equation editor.

The number of figures should not exceed 5. The figures should be located within the text using figure captions. Only grayscale figures should be included in the printed version of the paper.

The first page of article should contain the article title, the name and complete institutional affiliation of each author, and an abstract (the abovementioned would be presented also in Armenian and Russian). The abstract should be no longer than 100 words and should be followed by **Keywords** (regardless of the article language the **Keywords** must be in English). The first footnote on the first page should point to the e-mail address of corresponding author.

The article structure typically consists of the following sections: **Introduction, Results and Discussions, Conclusion and References** (the author can use any other sections).

The references should be presented in the language of original in following style:

- for articles: authors' names, full title // journal name (using standard abbreviations) year, volume and issue number, page numbers;
- for books: authors' names, full title, publisher, year, total number of pages.

Pre- and Post-Printing Process. In case of acceptance of the manuscript for publishing the corresponding author will receive the galley proofs for checking the corrections.

After publication, coauthors will receive 5 reprints and the corresponding author will receive a hard copy of the journal free of charge.
