These activities aim to support those students who are preparing themselves academically and socially for studying in the U.S. While participating in CCC does not guarantee admission, it is designed to significantly improve self-organized and independent Armenian students' chances for acceptance to U.S. universities.

- Be prepared to take admission tests like TOEFL/SAT/GRE
- Strengthen your essay writing and other important skills for strong application
