

**International cooperation under the grant "The role and significance of the Eastern Partnership in the process of transformation of the countries of Eastern Europe and the South Caucasus".**

We would like to inform you that Yerevan State University implements the international project "The role and importance of the Eastern Partnership in the process of transformation of the countries of Eastern Europe and the South Caucasus" in cooperation with the Jagiellonian University in Krakow.

The aim of the project is to conduct research on the role of the Eastern Partnership in the process of transformation of the countries covered by the program and to analyze the impact of individual tools in the field of systemic changes in Armenia, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine.

The project is implemented by an international consortium of universities, which includes the Jagiellonian University in Krakow, Ivan Franko National University of Lviv, Yerevan State University, Moldova State University, Tbilisi State University and the International Security and Partnership Centre (ISPC) in Lviv.

The head of the Project is Prof. Piotr Bajor from the Institute of Political Science and International Relations of the Jagiellonian University in Krakow. The project representatives from Yerevan State University are: Prof. Alexander Markarow and Prof. Narek S. Galstyan. Prof. Samvel Hovhanisyan from Brusov State University is also a member of the research group.
