I would like to inform you about the application process for one term mobility in academic year 2019/2020 at the Philosophical faculty, University of Hradec Králové (UHK), Czech Republic. Complete information is on the [webpage](#). The deadline for the applications is:

UHK offers accommodation at students' dormitory, the living costs in Hradec Králové are low (250–450 USD per month). Ca. 60-70 international students study at the Philosophical Faculty every term.

We would like to offer you a scholarship for **two students** from your University. This scholarship applies to a **one-term study at the University of Hradec Králové, during the first term of the next academic year (from September 2019 until February 2020).**

With this scholarship, we intend to strengthen the excellent relationship between our universities within the framework of our agreement of cooperation, and to honor your willingness to accept our students for studying at your university.

The scholarship applies to our semester-long **program taught in English** at the Philosophical Faculty, which includes courses covering topics from political science, sociology, philosophy, history and social work. The program is designed for students, who wish to foster their knowledge of European politics, society and thoughts. The list of courses offered is available on our [website](#).

We suppose that, if interested in this opportunity, your University would organize the selection process of candidates and also would choose students of study fields related to those mentioned in table above.

In addition to this, we offer the opportunity of attending the **Summer School of Czech Language and Culture** to students selected by your university for a study stay at the Philosophical Faculty UHK. It is a one-month length summer school (it will take place from 15<sup>th</sup> August till 18<sup>th</sup> September 2019), within which the students visit Czech language classes, English language classes (if interested), academic lectures and also attend events and trips organized by Philosophical Faculty UHK. This summer school is the reason for early deadline of applications for winter term 2019/2020 (28<sup>th</sup> February 2019). You will find more information on it soon on our [website](#).

Thanks to a financial contribution of the Ministry of Education of the Czech Republic we are thus able to offer to each of two of your students the possibility of a scholarship worth 20 000 Czech crowns (approximately 875 USD). There are no other conditions attached to receiving this scholarship and we would completely entrust you with the selection process of the students.

**Notice:** The price of the Summer School for students is 300 EUR (approx. 7 800 CZK). Each student, who wants to participate in Summer School of Czech Language and Culture, must pay this fee. Whole scholarship of 20 000 CZK is meant as a support for student and it doesn't cover whole stay of students at UHK. We will send the Confirmation of Scholarship together with the documents for each student, but each of them will have to prove the rest of funds himself/herself at the embassy, when he/she will apply for a visa. Student will receive the scholarship after his/her arrival to Hradec Králové to bank account he/she will found in the Czech Republic.

Therefore, I would like to kindly ask you whether your university would be interested in offering this scholarship to two of your students, so we would be able to start planning this exchange.

Additionally, your university can nominate another student(s) without a claim for UHK scholarship. The fact that the student is/is not a candidate for UHK scholarship **must be clearly stated in Nomination form** (available on our [website](#), there are different forms, please, choose the proper one). Our semester-long program is without a tuition fee.

**Students have to submit complete application until 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to [tomas.hercik@uhk.cz](mailto:tomas.hercik@uhk.cz). The Application Form and other required documents are available on our [website](#).**

**All applications must be sent on time and no late applications will be accepted.**
