

Notification: Summer Short-Term Program in Kyoto
Center for the Promotion of Global Education (R-Globe)
Ryukoku University

The Ryukoku University Center for the Promotion of Global Education (R-Globe) hereby welcomes international students to apply for the newly-launched Summer Short-Term Program, R-STEP (**Ryukoku Short-Term Experience Program**) on our Fukakusa Campus in beautiful Kyoto City. The program provides specially designed courses in Japanese language, history, and culture and includes lectures in [Japanese Language], [Society and Culture in Japan], and [Buddhism in Japan]. We give students the opportunity to explore past and present Japan through excursions to locations throughout the Kansai area which have been known to evoke images of the country. Eligibility requirements and application procedures are as follows:

1. Location

Lectures: Fukakusa Campus (Kyoto), Ryukoku University
Field Trips: Mainly Kyoto, with some excursions to Osaka

2. Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must currently be registered at one of Ryukoku University's Partner Institutions

4. Program Fee

280,000 JPY

- * Accommodation and expenses related to Field Trips/Cultural Experiences within the Program are included in the program cost. It will be necessary for the program participant to cover the fees of round-trip airfare (one's own country/region ⇔ Japan) and domestic transportation expenses in Japan (such as between the airport and the university, and between the accommodation and the university) separately.
- * After applying, participants who are accepted into the program will receive an email with instructions regarding the payment of the program fee. Your application will be considered complete once the payment is made according to the instructions within one week. Please note that if the payment is not completed by the payment deadline, your application will not be confirmed as accepted.
- * If at least 10 participants are not gathered, the program will be either cancelled or postponed.
- * In the case too many applications are received (20 participants), the number of participants may be determined by lottery.
- * If the capacity is reached, the recruitment may be closed even before the end of the application period.
- * It is possible for flight arrangements to be made through the University's designated travel agency. Please inform us if this is your preference.

5. Program Period : 7 July - 19 July 2025

- * Participants must make their own arrangements to arrive at the Ryukoku University-designated accommodation (currently being arranged near Kyoto Station or near Ryukoku University) between 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM on July 7 (Monday).
- * If you are unable to arrive during this time, please arrange to arrive in Japan on July 6 (Sunday) and stay one night at a hotel near Kyoto Station. Then, come to the designated accommodation (currently being arranged near Kyoto Station or near Ryukoku University) between 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM on July 7 (Monday).
- * Accommodations for this program are secured from July 7 (Monday · Arrival Date) to July 19 (Saturday · Departure Date). Please make your own arrangements for accommodations outside of this period.

We are considering accommodations either near Kyoto Station or close to Ryukoku University. These dorms are provided through our partner school, Temple University, and are located in nearly new apartment buildings. Each unit is a private room equipped with a kitchen, bathroom, and toilet, as well as a microwave, refrigerator, electric kettle, desk, and washing machine. These well-furnished rooms provide a comfortable and private living environment, making them very popular among international students.

Accommodation costs are covered by the program fee.
