

This is an innovation and entrepreneurship competition jointly organized by 12 ministries and commissions, including the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China and local governments. No matter your nationality or background, everyone can shine on this stage and pursue their entrepreneurial dream

This is a world-class event that has been successfully held eight times. It is an innovation and entrepreneurship project exhibition utilizing the new concept of "Internet+" as the main theme of the Competition. It addresses the practical needs of society and the economy and reflects the achievements of new engineering, medicine, agriculture, and liberal arts methods and practices in colleges. It is a high-value competition with a great number of participants, large scale and huge impact. So far, it has witnessed nearly 10 million teams and 40 million college students from more than 120 countries coming together to brainstorm, share wisdom, and build for the future.

The aura of the invigorating eighth competition still resonates today. It saw the submission of 3.4 million projects, with 14.5 million people from five continents, 107 countries and regions, and 1345 foreign universities participating, all of which set new records.



The 2023 competition brings the world's attention to the city of Tianjin and Tianjin University, the first modern university in China. Tianjin is the largest port in northern China with a history of more than 600 years, known as the "hometown of folk art" and "world architecture expo", and is the birthplace of modern higher education in China.

Dare to differ, dare to win. Join the competition.

Maybe you will win seed capital for your entrepreneurial endeavors. 500 projects will enter the Competition finals. The top 150 projects will enter the on-site finals, 50 of these will receive the Gold Award, while the remaining 100 projects will receive the Silver Award. The 350 projects that fail to make it to the on-site finals will receive the Bronze Award. If the project team was recommended by Tianjin University to participate in the competition and wins a gold award in the finals, it can receive a reward of up to ¥500,000.

Maybe you will expand into the Chinese market and gain the attention of angel investors. The Competition's judges include representatives of domestic and foreign investment and financing institutions, while leaders from technology parks and enterprise incubation parks will be on site for observation purposes. They will provide you with full-chain development suggestions from the creative innovation stage to product landing, from harvesting investment and financing to incubation development.

At the same time, you will gain the opportunity to improve your entrepreneurial abilities, establish a global circle of like-minded friends and future partners, and explore Tianjin and experience the charm of China's first modern university.

First of all, please choose the proper competition category. All submissions will be divided into one of the following two categories according to entrants' academic status: Undergraduate or Postgraduate. Submissions will be further divided into three sub-categories based on the projects' business start-up stage: Creativity, Emerging Projects, and Rising Projects.

- 1.1. Creativity. Projects in the Creativity category should have mature product prototypes or service models without the need to register a company. Only on-campus students can join this category.
- 1.2. Emerging Projects. Projects should have completed business registration within the past three years (after March 1, 2020).
- 1.3. Rising Projects. Projects should have completed business registration over 3 years ago (prior to March 1, 2020).
